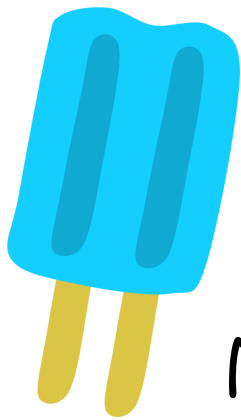

## **SESSION THEMES and INFORMATION**

### **Camp Session Themes and Dates**

#### **Session 1: 5/31– 6/3 “Magic Carnival”**

Come to the BGCE Big Top , where campers will engage in a range of extraordinary feats and illusions. Field Trips to WonderLab and Bryan Park Pool.

#### **Session 2: 6/6- 6/10 “Mission Impossible”**

Your mission, if you choose to accept it, is a week of challenges, mazes, obstacles, and gadgets. Field Trips to the Cascades Park and Bryan Park Pool.

#### **Session 3: 6/13- 6/17 “The Happiest Place on Earth”**

Once upon a time, at the Boys & Girls Club, fairy tales come to life as campers imagine and create classic Disney stories. Field Trips to Camp Rock and Bryan Park Pool.

#### **Session 4: 6/20 –6/24 “Creative Kids”**

Calling all artists, actors, singers, or anyone who is ready for curtain call. This week, we will have a talent show, crafts, and other activities to spark campers’ creativity. Field trips to Bryan Park Pool and TBA.

#### **Session 5: 6/27 - 7/1 “America the Beautiful”**

As we approach Independence Day, campers will participate in activities, games, and crafts celebrating Red, White, and Boys & Girls Club Blue. Mini Golf and to Bryan Park Pool.

#### **Session 6: 7/5 - 7/8 “Olympics”**

Get your game face on! This week campers will participate in lots of active games while learning about team work and good sportsmanship. Field trips to Indianapolis Indians Game and Bryan Park Pool.

#### **Session 7: 7/11- 7/15 “Oregon Trail”**

As you make your journey westward, take a pit-stop at the Boys & Girls Club. Your camper will be transported to the 1800s to play games and activities from this time. BGCE or bust! Field trips to Cabin Museum and Bryan Park Pool.

#### **Session 8: 7/18- 7/22 “Lions & Tigers & Bears, Oh My”**

It’s a jungle out there! Join us as we explore our amazing planet and all of its inhabitants. Field trip to the Indianapolis Zoo and Bryan Park Pool.

#### **Session 9: 7/25 - 7/29 “Controlled Chaos”**

Campers will have a chance to play messy and crazy games during *Controlled Chaos!* On certain days, a change of clothes will be necessary. Field Trips to Indianapolis Children’s Museum and to Bryan Park Pool.

#### **Session 10: 8/1– 8/3 “Around the World”**

Grab your passport and pack a suitcase as we fly around the world in three days. Campers will celebrate different cultures and learn about diversity. Field Trip to Cascades Park.

### **Who can register for camp?**

Campers who attend Summer Camp must be between the ages of 6 and 14 (unless applying for Junior Counselor Program—see below). Campers must be capable of participating positively in a group setting . Campers should also be capable of taking direction from adult leaders, and be independent enough to care for their own belongings and basic personal needs.

All campers must become Club members to attend Summer Camp. Boys & Girls Club membership costs \$20.00 annually.

### **Camp Hours**

- **7:15-8:00am: Early Bird Drop off (Extra Weekly Fee)**
- **8:00-9:00am: Drop off & Breakfast**
- **9:00-12:00pm: Camp Hours (doors are locked)**
- **12:00-6:00pm: Drop in (free for all non-camp members) & Pick Up**

**\*Important Note: Many camp field trips return between 2pm-4pm. Check with camp staff to learn the specific times to pick up your child from the club.**

### **Junior Counselor Program**

Campers between the ages of 13-17 who have attended the Club as a member of the Teen Program for at least one full school year are eligible to apply to our Junior Counselor (J.C.) Program. Members who have previously completed one full school year as a member of our Junior Staff Program will be given preference.

Our J.C. program allows our older campers to engage in a meaningful mentoring role and learn valuable career building skills. More information can be found in our required J.C. Registration Application, which can be acquired at the front desk.

### **Family Orientation**

Once campers are registered, parents are strongly encouraged to attend one Family Orientation. Family orientations will take place on:

- **Wednesday, May 18th, from 6:00pm-7:00pm**
- **Saturday, May 21st from 12:00pm-1:00pm**

Family Orientation will allow you to ask questions, learn about the Club and your child’s upcoming camp experience, finalize paperwork, and meet camp staff!

### **What Parents can Expect**

Each week, campers will be a divided into teams. Campers will spend time daily with their team and team counselor, as well as participating in all camp games and activities. Activities will include art projects, active games, scavenger hunts, science experiments and team building games. Every Tuesday afternoon, there will also be a water day, where campers who bring a change of clothes can choose to play water games.

Parents can expect a 1:10 staff-to-member ratio. Campers will experience a variety of fun and engaging outdoor activities, active games, art activities and field trips led by trained camp staff. Staff are trained in areas such as safety and risk management, behavior management and conflict resolution. Lead staff are CPR and First Aid Certified.
